Speaker-Elect Thom Tillis has announced committee assignments for the upcoming session of the North Carolina House of Representatives. These announcements involve Representative Guice and impact the people of North Carolina House District 113. Several committees have been eliminated and combined to help with the efficiency of House operations. The session officially opens on January 26, 2011.



Representative Guice has been appointed Chair of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Justice and Public Safety.
